

Vintage Jewelry Box

I made in advance a silicone mold of a vintage cameo and a bow which I got from some jewelry I had. In the silicone mold I also included an old button. To make the mold, I used Silicone Plastique® from Make Your Own Molds. You may also purchase ready made silicone molds.

Supplies:

- 10 oz. fondant with ½ tsp tylose
- Round cutter set
- Rolling pin
- Pearl dusts (Claret, Super Pearl, Old Gold)
- Fuchsia gel color
- Painting brushes
- Spatulas
- Pearl silicone mold
- 4" round cake board or base
- 2/16" width Fuchsia ribbon
- Quilting embosser patchwork plaque
- Silicone Plastique® (to make a mold if you don't already have one you could use)
- ¾ cup royal icing, soft consistency



Rice Krispie® Treats – RKT:

Ingredients

- 4 cups (1 lb. bag) Rice Krispies® or similar cereal
- 5 cups (16 oz. bag) mini-marshmallows
- ¼ cup butter or vegetable oil

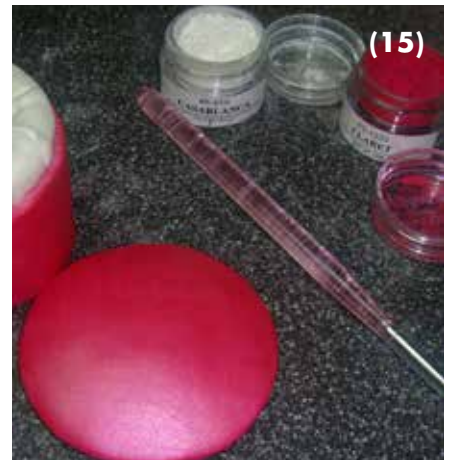
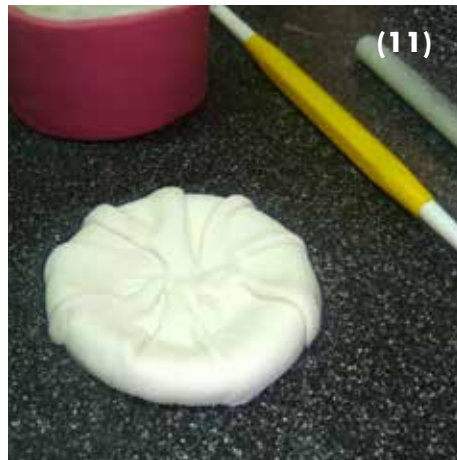
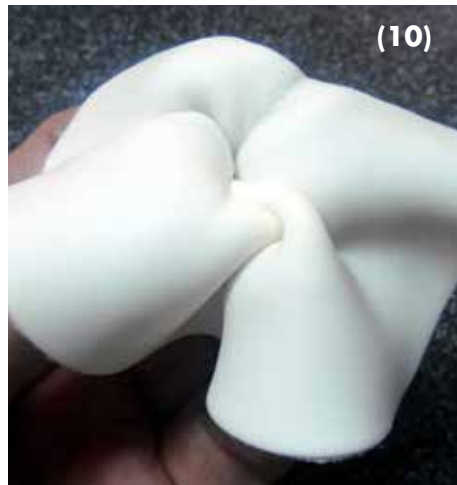
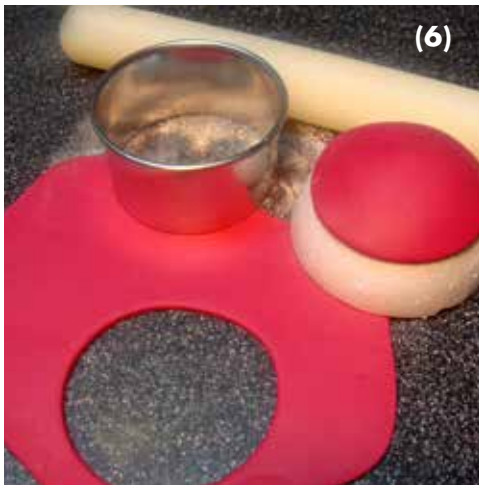
Instructions

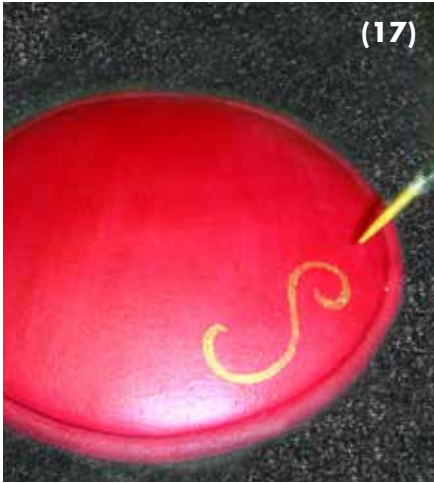
1. Melt the butter thoroughly in a medium sized pot.
2. Add the marshmallows.
3. Keep mixing until the marshmallows melt.
4. Add cereal.
5. Stir quickly to make sure all the cereal gets covered in marshmallow.
6. Put in a mold, press to compact the plaque and leave it until firm or put in the fridge so it sets quickly.

1. When ready, mold the figures in fondant and let dry.
2. Make fondant pearls using the pearl mold and glue them around the Cameo. (1)
3. Prepare the Rice Krispie® Treats as indicated in the Supply and Recipe list. (You could also use a cupcake instead.)
4. Prepare royal icing.
5. Cut two 2.5" round pieces of Rice Krispie® Treats and put one over the other. (2)
6. Cover with royal icing and let it dry. (3)
7. Measure the cake and cut a fuchsia fondant strip. (4)
8. Cover it all around. (5)
9. Cut a 2.5" circle of fuchsia fondant and place this circle on a curved surface.
10. Leave to dry. This will make the cover of the box. (6)
11. Cut a 2" circle of white fondant and let it dry. (7)
12. Using white fondant make a log shaped strip. With a paint brush put water around the top edge of the white circle and glue ends of log. Then push the fondant towards the center. (8 & 9)
13. Cut a 4" fondant circle, create folds by holding it from the center. (10)
14. Place it over the circle and fold it downwards, gluing it with a little bit of water, simulating fabric. (11)
15. Roll fondant and emboss it using a patchwork quilting plaque and cut a 2" circle, which will be glued to the inside of the jewelry box cover. (12)
16. Color white parts with Super Pearl luster dust. (13)
17. Color fuchsia parts with Claret luster dust. (14)
18. With royal icing, glue the white fabric-like piece to the top of the box. (15)
19. With a clay gun, using a medium round hole disk, make a simple cord and glue it around the upper part of the box and around the box cover. (16)
20. Draw scrolls using a brush with golden luster dust on the cover as well as around the box. (17)
21. Color the bow, pearls and cord with golden luster dust. With royal icing attach the button in the center of the box cover. Attach the bow to the front part of the box and the cameo to top. (18)
22. Cover the cake board or base with fondant and glue the ribbon around it. Put the jewelry box on top of the covered cake board. (19)
23. Finished Vintage Jewelry Box. (20)
